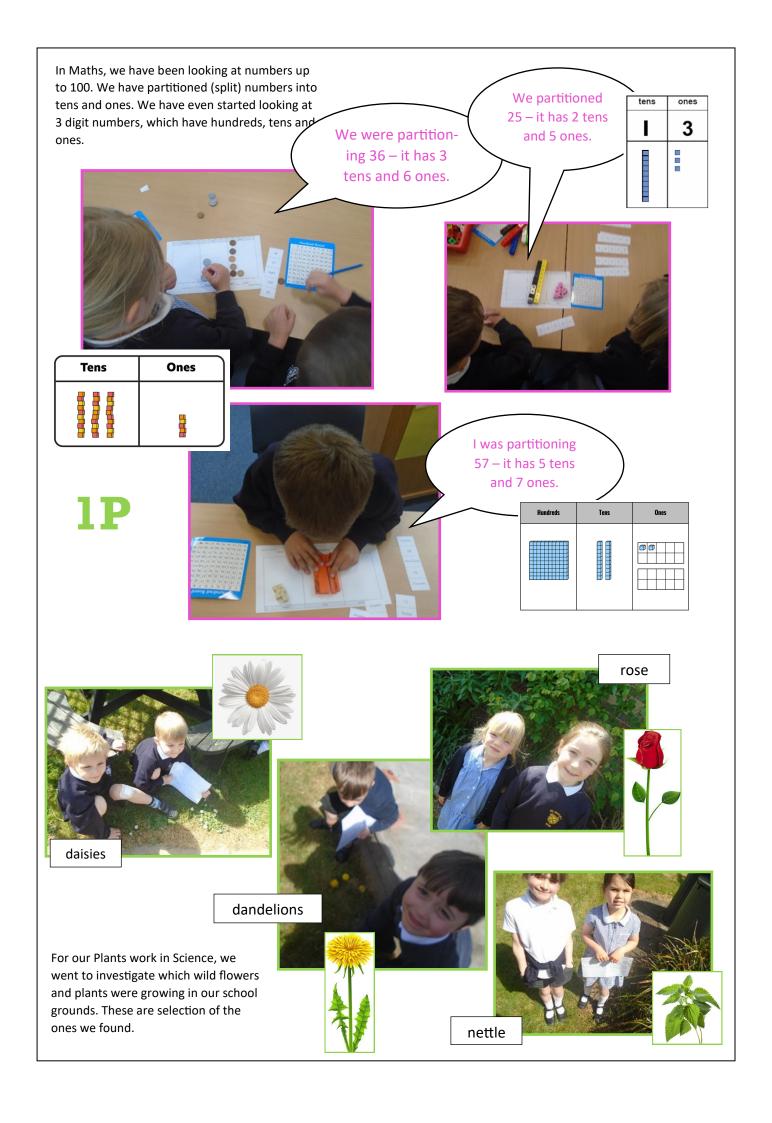

After a long absence, Father Nick came and held an act of worship with us this week. We celebrated St George's Day.

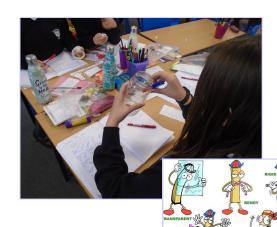
# Properties of Materials
